Categories:

Ages 11-13 years (as of Dec 31, 2016)

Ages 14-19 years (as of Dec 31, 2016)

An award will be presented for the most outstanding entry in each category, as selected by the jurors.

Youth works will be displayed at the opening exhibit.

Reminder: youth entries must be mounted, but framing is not required.

Peoples' Choice Award

A popular feature: presented to the work receiving the most votes from those in attendance at the opening reception.

Ten works will be selected from the Travelling Gallery to be exhibited at the R&N Show sponsored by the Manitoba Arts Network in Wpg in July 2017.

Chris Reid completed her BFA and BEd at the U of Alberta and her MFA at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. In 2000, Chris relocated her family to Brandon when she was

THE JURIED SHOW

Westman Region artists are invited to enter the 38th Annual Westman Juried Art Show to be held Saturday, April 29, 2017 at the Alexander School, 102 Argyle St, Alexander hosted by the Alexander School and the Arts West Council. The opening reception will be held at 2:00 p.m.; doors will open at 1:30 and close at 3:30 p.m. The exhibition will be available for public viewing only at the opening reception. The number of works to be displayed will be at the discretion of the jurors. The jurors will be available during the afternoon to meet with artists for informal discussion of their critiques.

DELIVERY AND PICKUP OF WORKS

Works may be delivered to MB Children & Youth Opportunities, Rm 335, 9th St, Brandon (Provincial Bldg) anytime before noon on April 27th or between 12:30 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. at Alexander school on April 27.

Note: works must be wrapped suitably for transport by car.

Artists are requested to make arrangements to pick up works not selected for the Travelling Gallery on Saturday, April 29th between 3:30 and 4:00 p.m. from the School.

THE TRAVELLING GALLERY

From the opening exhibit, the jurors will select 20 works for the Travelling Gallery, which will tour communities in the Westman Region over the following year. Jurors' selection is final. Crates will be used for the transportation of the Gallery. All works will be insured from arrival at the Juried Show and the Travelling Gallery works for the year on tour. At the conclusion of the tour, the Arts West Council will arrange return of works to the artists.

To be eligible for the Travelling Gallery, works must measure no more than 27" by 27", no less than 11" by 14", including frame. Works not meeting these size restrictions will be accepted for the Juried Show only.

REGULATIONS

1. Artists must reside in the Westman Region and be at least 11 years of age as of December 31, 2016 .
2. Prizes are restricted to two Youth Awards.
3. Each artist may enter a maximum of two works, regardless of category.
4. The categories are: Painting-any medium; Printmaking; Drawing-any medium; Silkscreen; Scratch Art, Mixed Media, 2D Fiber Art.
5. All works submitted to this Juried Show must be **original works of art**, completed within the past 12 months. Reference photos must be those of the artist; otherwise, written permission for use of photos by other people must accompany the entry. **Works that do not meet these criteria will be disqualified.** (If written permission cannot be obtained, do not submit the work.)
6. Framing requirements: **Adults**-all works must be in a solid frame, ready for hanging (includes gallery mounting). Install sturdy hooks and wire on the back, 1/3 of way below top of frame. **Youth**-all works must be mounted; framing not required.
7. Previous winning entries of any juried show are not eligible.
8. Labels contained in this brochure are to be firmly attached to the backs of works.
9. **Works are to remain on display until 3:30 p.m. No exceptions will be made.**
10. Artists whose works are selected for the Travelling Gallery must permit their works to remain displayed and toured for a period of one year.

NEW THIS YEAR!! OPTIONAL THEME CATEGORY "HERITAGE: VISIONS OF THE PAST"

The same Juried Show now includes an optional theme category. Artists are invited to consider entering one or both works into our theme category: "Heritage: Visions of the Past". All "Heritage" entries must meet Westman Juried Show regulations as stated in this brochure and will be eligible for the Travelling Gallery.
