Ages 11-13 years (Sponsor: Arts West Council)

All participants will be awarded a small prize of art

An award will be presented for the most outstanding
entry as selected by the jurors.

Reminder: youth entries must be mounted, but
framing is not required.

Peoples' Choice Award (Sponsor: Lasting Image)

An award will be presented to the work
receiving the most votes from those in attendance
at the opening reception.

Janet Shaw-Russell has lived in

years. She is a co-founder of

THE JURIED SHOW

Westman Region artists are invited to enter the 41st Annual Westman Juried Art Show to be held Saturday, May 2, 2020 at the Killarney School, hosted by Killarney-Turtle Mountain Arts Council and Arts West Council. The opening reception will be held at 2:00 pm; doors will open at 1:30 and close at 3:30 pm. The exhibition will be available for public viewing only at the opening reception. All works, unless disqualified by the jurors will be displayed at the opening reception. The jurors will be available during the afternoon to meet with artists for informal discussion of their critiques.

DELIVERY AND PICKUP OF WORKS

Works may be delivered to MB Municipal Relations, Rm 335, 340 - 9th St, Brandon (Provincial Bldg) anytime before noon on April 30th or between 2:30 and 3:00 pm at Killarney School on April 30.

Note: works must be wrapped suitably for transport by car.

Artists are requested to make arrangements to pick up works not selected for the Travelling Gallery on Saturday, May 2 between 3:30 and 4:00 pm from Killarney School.

THE TRAVELLING GALLERY

From the opening exhibit, the jurors will select 20 works for the Travelling Gallery, which will tour communities in the Westman Region over the following year. Jurors' selection is final. Crates will be used for the transportation of the Gallery. All works will be insured from arrival at the Juried Show and the Travelling Gallery works for the year on tour. At the conclusion of the tour, the Arts West Council will arrange return of works to the artists.

To be eligible for the Travelling Gallery, works must measure no more than 27" by 27", no less than 11" by 14", including frame. Works not meeting these size restrictions will be accepted for the Juried Show only.

REGULATIONS

1. Artists must reside in the Westman Region and be at least 11 years of age as of December 31, 2019.
2. Prizes are restricted to Youth Awards and People's Choice.
3. Each artist may enter a maximum of two works, regardless of category.
4. The categories are: Painting-any medium; Printmaking; Drawing-any medium; Silkscreen; Scratch Art, Mixed Media, 2D Fibre Art.
5. All works submitted to this Juried Show must be **original hand-made works of art**, completed within the past 12 months. Reference photos must be those of the artist; written permission for use of photos by other people must accompany the entry. **Works that do not meet these criteria will be disqualified.** (If written permission cannot be obtained, do not submit the work.)
6. Framing requirements: **Adults**-all works must be in a solid frame, ready for hanging (includes gallery mounting). Install sturdy hooks and wire on the back, approximately 3 inches below top of frame. **Youth**-all works must be mounted; framing not required.
7. Labels contained in this brochure are to be firmly attached to the backs of works.
8. **Works are to remain on display until 3:30 pm. No exceptions will be made.**
9. Artists whose works are selected for the Travelling Gallery must permit their works to remain displayed and toured for a period of one year.

OPTIONAL THEME CATEGORY -

"MANITOBA – 150 YEARS"

The same Juried Show includes an optional theme category. In recognition of our Province's 150th anniversary, artists are invited to enter one or both works into our theme category: "MANITOBA" - 150 YEARS". "MANITOBA" entries must meet Westman Juried Show regulations as stated in this brochure and will be eligible for the Travelling Gallery.
