THE JURIED SHOW

Due to the uncertainties of the Covid pandemic, the Westman Juried Art Show will not be held in its usual format in 2021. Regional artists are invited to enter the Westman Juried Art Show to be held as an **ONLINE GALLERY** from July 1 – August 31, 2021, sponsored by the Arts West Council and the Manitoba Arts Network. The Norman, Parkland, Eastman and Central Juried Art Show galleries will be exhibited simultaneously. Entries from youth and adult artists are welcome. Because of the virtual format, the number of entries to be accepted will be limited as follows:

Adult Gallery: 75 pieces, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Youth Gallery: 25 pieces, on a first-come, first-served basis.

PROCESS

Artists will submit photographic images of their piece(s) using the online entry form. Artists must have/create a gmail account to access the entry form: [Gmail: Setting Up a Gmail Account \(gcfglobal.org\)](mailto:gcfglobal.org) All pieces, unless disqualified by the jurors will be displayed in the online gallery. Juror critiques will be provided for all entries. Jurors will select 10 pieces for exhibition in the Manitoba Arts Network Rural & Northern Art Show.

AWARDS

Honourable Mentions

At the discretion of the jurors, Honourable Mentions may be awarded to works that have not been selected to the Rural & Northern Art Show.

Youth Awards

Categories (as of Dec 31, 2020):

Ages 11-13 years (Sponsor: Arts West Council)

All participants will be awarded a small prize of art supplies.

Ages 14-19 years (Sponsor: Lasting Image, Brandon)

An award will be presented for the most outstanding entry as selected by the jurors.

Rural & Northern Art Show

Ten works will be selected for exhibition in the online R&N Show sponsored by the Manitoba Arts Network in the Fall of 2021. Note: MAN will charge a registration fee to artists who opt to participate in the R&N Show.

REGULATIONS

1. Artists must reside in the Westman Region and be at least 11 years of age as of December 31, 2020.
2. Each artist may enter a maximum of two pieces, regardless of category.
3. The categories are: Painting-any medium; Printmaking; Drawing-any medium; Silkscreen; Scratch Art, Mixed Media, 2D Fibre Art.
4. All pieces submitted to this Juried Show must be **original hand-made works of art**, completed within the past 12 months. Reference photos must be those of the artist; written permission for use of photos by other people must accompany the entry. **Works that do not meet these criteria will be disqualified.** (If written permission cannot be obtained, do not submit the work).
5. Photographic requirements: high resolution cropped jpeg image, preferably 1 – 3 MB size per image.
6. Framing: for ease of photography, framing is **NOT** required.
7. Prizes are restricted to Youth Awards.

JURORS



Janet Shaw-Russell, a Winnipeg artist, called southwestern Manitoba home for 37 years. During that time, she co-founded the art collective, Drawn Together comprised of women artists from across the region. Her multi-media artwork has been exhibited throughout

Manitoba and Saskatchewan including the Art Gallery of Southwestern Manitoba and the Estevan Art Gallery and Museum. She is a Canada Council and Manitoba Arts Council grant recipient and former MAWA mentorship mentee.



Michael Boss is an artist and educator living in Winnipeg. His artwork ranges from drawing and painting to photography, sculpture, installation, performance and writing. His work has been exhibited in exhibitions across Canada, in the USA and Europe. Michael held the position of Asst Professor of Fine Art at Mount Allison and Lakehead Universities. He was Head of Education at The Art Gallery of Southwestern Manitoba for 7 years and was Head of Studio Programs at The Winnipeg Art Gallery from 1998-2014.
